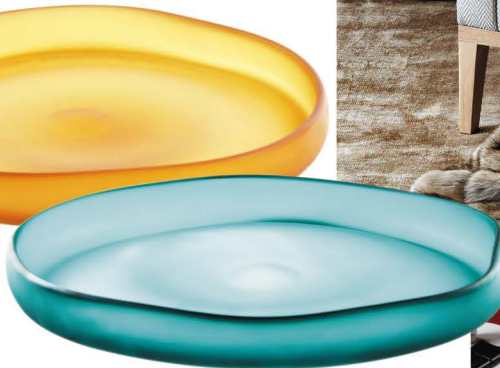
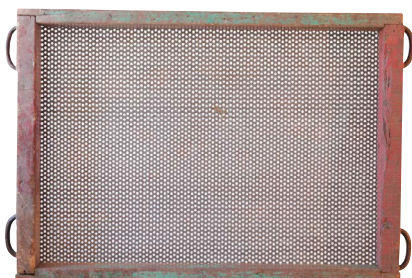
Touch of GLASS
